STARS Qualifier for 148cms & Under and Exc. 148cms.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN SHOW PONIES - Open Show Pony - Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cm. Any Suitable sized rider. **Classes may be divided as follows:** Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms.

EQUIFEST YOUNG RIDERS - Mare or Gelding exceeding 146cm but not exceeding 158cm riders not to have attained their 25th Birthday before 1st of Jan in current year.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN HACKS - Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age. **Classes may be divided as follows:** Small Hacks – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms. Riders any age. Large Hacks – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDING HORSE - Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age. **Classes may be divided as follows:** Small Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age. Large Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.



Class 5. Ridden Coloured Plaited

Including Spotted, Roan & Palomino but they are NOT eligible for CHAPS (UK) or STARS qualifier.

EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD/SKEWBALD - Open ridden Piebald/Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship subject to their show rules & conditions. Spurs may not be worn by a rider on a pony (n/e 153cms). No pony under 153cms will be ridden by the judge.



Class 6. Ridden Show Hunter Pony 153cms & under

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES - Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Any suitable sized rider. Classes may be divided as follows: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 123cms. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 123cms but not exceeding 133cms. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms.



Class 7. Ridden Show Hunter Horse Exceeding 153cms

EQUIFEST YOUNG RIDERS - Mare or Gelding exceeding 153cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th Birthday before 1st of Jan in current year.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN HUNTERS - Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN SMALL HUNTERS - Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.



Class 8. Ridden Sports Pony/Horse, ROR & Foreign Breeds

The highest placed ROR will qualify for STARS.

EQUIFEST OPEN RE-TRAINED RACE HORSES - Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height. Horses must have been raced in the GB to be eligible to compete. Riders any age.

EQUIFEST JUNIOR RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND - Mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective pure bred Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A,B,C & D. Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their **14th** birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their **18th** birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Classes 12 & 13

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND - Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.



Class 12. Ridden Mountain and Moorland Large Breeds

Large Breeds - Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D. Riders any age.



Class 13. Ridden Mountain and Moorland Small Breeds

Small Breeds - Shetlands, Welsh Section A and B, Dartmoor and Exmoor. Riders any age.



Class 14. Ridden Coloured Native, Cob and Traditional Cob

Including Spotted, Roan & Palomino but they are NOT eligible for CHAPS(UK) or STARS qualifiers.

EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD - Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship subject to their show rules & conditions. Spurs may not be worn by any rider on a pony (not exceeding 153cm). Riders any age. **Classes may be divided as follows: Open Lightweight Ridden Cob**, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hoggied and trimmed. Riders any age.

Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob - Mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hoggied and trimmed. Riders any age.

EQUIFEST OPEN MAXI COBS - Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. To be shown hoggied and trimmed. Riders any age.

CHAPS - Affiliation Number: 26-059

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 26-059. Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card. Members to apply in to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 20th - 22nd August 2026 at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire, NG32 2EF.

Equine Sports UK

This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championship taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 30th July - 1st August 2026. The three highest placed competitors will qualify in each class.

Equifest

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 5th - 8th August 2026. The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. No membership is required to enter these classes.

NCPA Pony of the Year Show

This show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A Pony of the Year Show in September. First & second prizewinners in the appropriate classes will qualify. POYS will be held on 13th September 2026 at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, L37 0AN.

TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes - Affiliation Number: TGCA/1805/ULT

No known breeding required to enter these classes. **TGCA Breed** classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. **Part Bred** classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". exhibit must have one parent that is pure bred traditional gypsy cob.

Stallions - All stallions (pure or part bred, four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class **MUST** be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.
