

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card. Members to apply in to CHAPS(UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 15th-18th August 2024. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS(UK) Members Handbook; or visit <u>www.chapsuk.com</u> Only "coloured" horses & ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK Members Handbook) may compete in these classes. All Stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK).All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.
